


# LIKE NO OTHER

In preparation for this day, we planned for 350 people to be in attendance. On September 7<sup>th</sup>, we dedicated our new church building for the Lord's work with over 500 people in attendance including our mayor and local government as well as many friends, family and neighbors. It was a Sunday like no other. After saying goodbye to the last visitor, our church family regrouped to thank the Lord for His provision and blessing. # MEDICAL MISSIONS OUTREACH

With the dedication behind us, we quickly transitioned to the arrival of a team of 35 doctors and volunteers from Medical Missions Outreach. They arrived just five days after the dedication to host a medical clinic in our neighborhood. Our people worked together to finish last minute details, print new outreach material and prepare to convert the church building into a temporary medical clinic.

The week began with a bilingual worship service. It's hard to describe of blessing of two groups of people from different countries and cultures coming together in worship and fellowship all because of the bond they share in Christ. The MMO team was such a blessing and encouragement to our people and the fellowship lingered throughout the day.

Beginning Monday morning, the church doors opened to our community where the doctors and volunteers of MMO treated 2,200 people over the next four days. They provided general care, eye exams and glasses, dental work and physical therapy. After each patient was treated, they sat down with one of our church members who shared a clear presentation of the Gospel. Many of our members recounted stories of individuals who said they never heard the Gospel presented as Jesus alone for salvation.

During these four days, we saw at least five individuals bow their heads to accept Christ as their Savior. Many seeds of the Word, however, were planted and on the following Sunday, after the MMO team had returned to the states, we had 30 visitors in attendance. When the invitation for salvation was given, another seven people raised their hands to receive Christ. Since then, we have been busy getting to know these individuals and preparing them for discipleship.

Time and space limit us in sharing all the details of these last two months. God has truly given us a time of ministry like no other and we praise Him for it. We also thank you for your faithful prayers. God has done great things on your behalf and for His glory!
